

## History Department Honors Distinction ASU Preparatory Academy (Phoenix)

Honors Distinction may be earned by completing one of two routes.



- 1. Meet college-ready Cambridge qualification score within the enrolled course:
  - a. IGCSE History (US) 0416 exam qualification score: C or better.
  - b. IGCSE History American (US) 0409 exam gualification score: C or better.



- 2. Develop and compete in the *National History Day* competition by producing work of original scholarship.
  - a. Through your participation in the contest, you will experience important benefits beyond learning about interesting issues, ideas, people, and events of your choosing. You will hone your expressive abilities as you demonstrate command of your topic and present your work in one of the competition's formats: paper, exhibit, performance, documentary, or website.

Each history expert is vying for a portion of more than **\$80,000** in prizes plus three college scholarships. First, second, and third place prizes are worth \$1,000, \$500, and \$250, respectively. Students also are eligible for more than two dozen special awards sponsored by various organizations, with values ranging from \$250 to \$2,500.

- First-place entries in the junior and senior division's five categories of documentary, exhibit, paper, performance, and website are given the title, "National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) Scholar" and receive a \$1,000 award sponsored by NEH. Second and third-place entries in all categories receive \$500 and \$250, respectively.
- Two entries from each NHD affiliate receive an "Outstanding Affiliate Entry" award sponsored by the National Park Service.
- More than two dozen special awards are presented for topics ranging from African American History to World War I. Sponsored by organizations from around the country, they are presented to outstanding entries in any category and range in value from \$250 to \$2,500.
- Three senior participants receive full or partial scholarships from Case Western Reserve University, Chaminade University in Honolulu, and the University of Maryland. These awards are chosen by university representatives.
